 - d. Radiator water level.

 - f. Fuel sedimenter for water or dirt contamination
 - g. Engine oil level

2. Carry out the following light and electrical system checks
 - a. Battery (under passenger seat)
 - i. Terminals are free from corrosion.
 - ii. Electrolyte level
 - iii. Use only distilled water to top up
 - b. Headlights (high and low beams)
 - c. Blinker lights (use hazard switch)
 - d. Tail lights (including Stop lights)
 - e. Reversing lights
 - f. Twin light flashers
 - g. Beacon

3. Do the following Cabin Checks (front)
 - a. Fuel level in tank
 - b. Center Console
 - i. Radio log
 - ii. Vehicle log is up to date.
 - iii. UBD map
 - iv. Compass
 - v. Garmin GPS (power up and get fix)
 - vi. Pens
 - vii. Fire gate keys
 - c. T-Card kit
 - d. District fire maps
 - e. Tabards
 - f. Interior lights
 - g. Siren
 - h. Horn

4. Rear Cabin
 - a. Shovel (1)
 - b. First-aid kit
 - c. High lift jack

5. Equipment Box
 - a. Torch (2)
 - b. Fuel funnel (1)
 - c. Tie down ropes (2)
 - d. Fire blanket
 - e. Reflective safety vests (2)
 - f. Oxyviva
 - g. Towing hitch and chain
 - h. Wheel brace
 - i. Hoenig branch
 - j. AWG branch
 - k. Stand pipe and Hydrant bar
 - l. 100ft 38mm hose (1)
 - m. 50ft 38mm hose (1)
 - n. Axe
