- a. Knapsacks (4), check pump action.
14. Main Pump
- a. Fuel, main and auxillary tanks
  - b. Oil level and colour (honey)
  - c. Heat exchanger level and colour (bright green)
  - d. Start and idle pump
  - e. Check suction hose is secured
15. Batteries
- a. Check eletrolyte level
  - b. Use only distilled water to top up
  - c. Check for corrosion on battery terminals
16. Main outboard fuel tanks
- a. Check fuel level in tanks
  - b. Use fuel from boat locker to top up
  - c. Check fuel filters for corrosion or leaks
17. Starboard Stern Locker
- a. Super fuel gerry tanks (red) (2)
  - b. Drip torch gerry tank (blue/red) (1)
  - c. Drip torch containers (2), must be empty
  - d. Drip torch nozzles (2)
  - e. VRO oil 4l
  - f. VRO oil level in outboard tanks > 50%
  - g. Chain saw fuel and bar oil kit
  - h. Fuel funnels (2)
18. Trickle charge is connected
19. Starboard Midships Locker
- a. Split sheet stretcher
  - b. First Aid box
  - c. Radio box
    - i. Handheld radios (3)
    - ii. Check transmission
    - iii. Check controls are free
    - iv. Spare batteries
    - v. Spare battery packs
    - vi. Spare spark plugs
    - vii. Spare bungs
    - viii. Spare battery isolation key
    - ix. Cylume sticks (3)
    - x. Dwyer wind meter
  - d. Fireground radio with ANR headset
  - e. Oxyviva, check cylinder pressure
  - f. Fire blanket, check it's dry
  - g. Change drinking water
- h. Ration Box
  - i. Billy
20. Starboard Forward Locker
- a. Full BA check
  - b. BACO board and china pencil.
  - c. Check locker for water and salt contamination.
  - d. Handheld compass
  - e. BFB map
  - f. Marine charts
  - g. UBD street map
  - h. Dangerous Goods handbook
  - i. Tide Chart
  - j. Radio log and pens
  - k. Torches (4) and spare batteries
21. External Checks
- a. Boat winch cable attached
  - b. Boat winch handle secured
  - c. Tire pressures
  - d. Propellers are smooth
  - e. Scupper flaps closed
